**“It is the Lord!”
“Come and have breakfast.”**

(John 21)

There are times when we feel like the disciples in today's Gospel - not sure when or if the Lord might return and not knowing what we are supposed to do as we wait. For me, this was during the pandemic, when I was not able to enter a church for nearly a year in order to prevent the spread of COVID. I related to the disciples, not knowing what to do on the edge of such a precipice, without my routine connection to the Lord.

When reading how Jesus appeared to the disciples after the Resurrection, I reflect on times when I did not initially recognize Jesus' presence in my own life, especially during the early days and months of the pandemic. I am reminded that it is not always through His presence in the flesh, but rather the compassionate action of others, that we see Jesus in our lives even today.

Today's Gospel is not just about the challenges of recognizing the Lord. It is also about how Jesus approaches Peter, reminding him that he is forgiven and still invited to follow. This shows us that it is not enough to see Jesus through the actions of others; we must respond to Jesus' invitation and lead by our own actions, so that those whom we meet may also see the Lord.

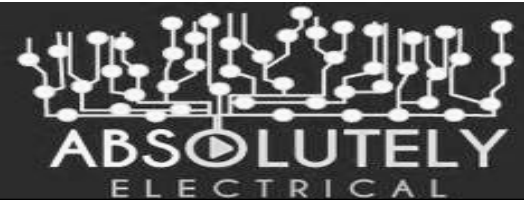
