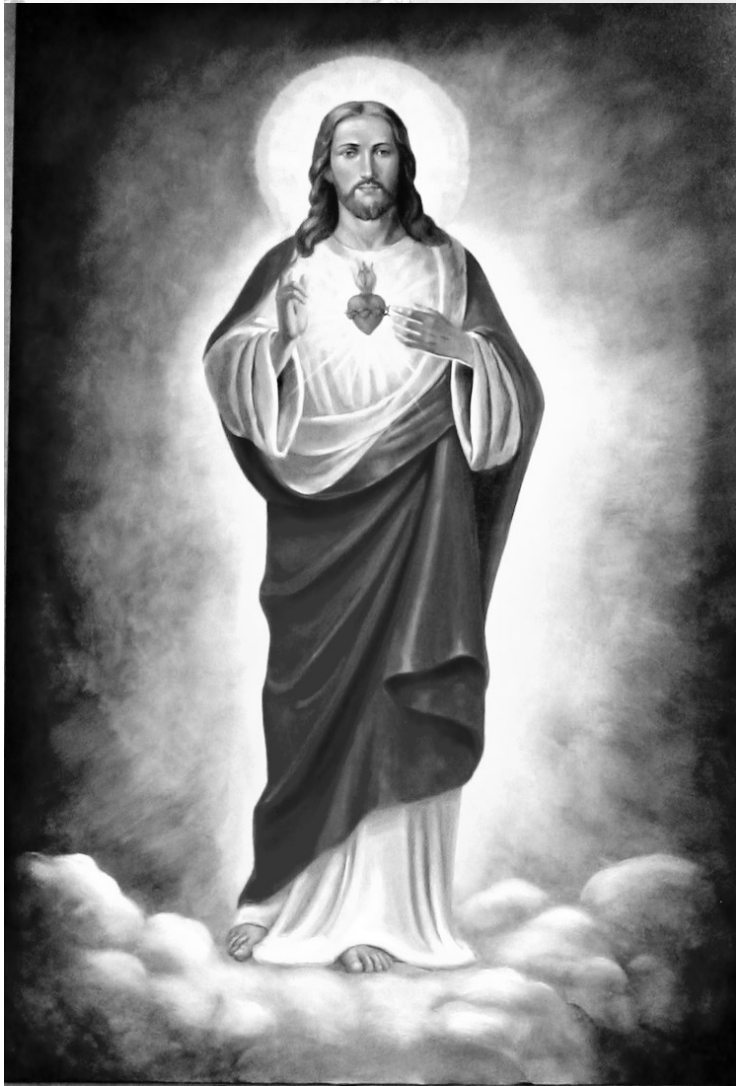

The purpose of the Gala is to raise funds for West Coast Missions: specifically, to fund two Religious of the Virgin Mary Sisters who will arrive this summer from the Philippines to minister in Ahousaht, located on the east side of Flores Island in Clayoquot Sound. The average annual cost to support two

Sisters in our Diocese is \$60,000. Our Gala will celebrate and financially support this renewed initiative of pastoral presence, and reaffirm our commitment to this journey with our Nuuchahnulth sisters and brothers.
