To the Korean Community & Fr. Marco Park. Thank you for making Sacred Heart Parish your home since 2009.

Jesus says something we need to pay attention to before he lists various apocalyptic happenings that are to come. He says, "Beware that you are not led astray; for many will come in my name and say, 'I am he!' and 'The time is near!' Do not go after them." His disciples had just demonstrated to him the human inclination to be very fascinated by the



end times. Even just last September there was a whole contingent of people who totally believed an African preacher who said the rapture was going to occur on the 23rd or 24th. They did not remember the words, "Do not go after them."

Has there ever been a time in history when there have not been nations rising up against nations or natural disasters or religious persecution? Was Jesus really telling his disciples how to tell when the end times are near or was he opening them up to the understanding that the institution of power that depended on blood sacrifice would start to crumble the moment he died? The temple they had been admiring was razed to the ground in 70 AD (very apocalyptic!) and there haven't been blood sacrifices offered there since then. What do the Jews offer instead? Sacrifices of praise.

We were reminded last week that we are temples of the Holy Spirit. Within that temple, we are called to offer sacrifices of praise. What does that mean? When the world feels out of control and we are stressed, anxious and angry, the very last thing we want to do is give praise to God. It truly is a sacrifice to take our thoughts off of circumstances that can feel pre-apocalyptic to give thanks. We want to name, blame and dissect the sources of our inner angry fear. We would often prefer to sacrifice inner peace rather than offer gratitude to God. Yet, in praise is where the power lies. When we praise, we are relinquishing control and judgement. We are saying to God, "Your business, not mine. I trust you." God takes that relinquishment very seriously.

Fear not. God dwells within the praises of his people.





Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary November 21

The Memorial of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the Temple recalls, according to the apocryphal gospels, the day on which Mary, while still a child, was brought to the temple in Jerusalem to be offered to God. The Church wants to emphasize not so much the historical event in itself, of which there is no trace in the Gospels, but the total gift

that Mary made of herself, by listening: "Blessed are those who hear the Word of God and observe it" (Lk. 11:28). This experience prepared the young girl from Nazareth to become the "temple of the Son of God".

The celebration of this feast dates back to the 6th century in the East with the dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary the New built by the Emperor Justinian I near the ruins of the temple in Jerusalem. There is evidence that various monasteries in Italy celebrated the feast in the 9th century. It was not until the 15th century that it was included in the Roman Missal.

This is also the day on which the Church celebrates the World Day of Cloistered Life, established by Pope Pius XII in 1953.

In Scripture, Mary is the woman who knows how to listen, who knows how to contemplate, who knows how to refer everything to her Son: "Do whatever He tells you" (Jn. 2:5). Mary is the One who never abandoned her Son Jesus, not even along the way of the Cross. She "stood" under the Cross. She is a disciple who never abandons the Lord Jesus, who always "stands behind" Him. All of this can help us imitate the Virgin Mary. Every Christian is called to look at Mary, to learn from her, to entrust themselves to her intercession and to guard the "purity of the faith" against any idols that surround us.




