Chrism Mass

On Thursday, March 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7:00pm, at the Cathedral, Bishop Gary Gordon will be the principal celebrant at a Mass that is celebrated annually.

At this liturgy, we gather around the bishop for the blessing and consecration of the oils that will be used in all our parishes in the coming year.

May our presence at the Chrism Mass be a sign of our support and gratitude for their ministry—and a reminder that baptism calls all of us to lives of service.

All are invited to attend. A reception will follow.

No final hymn during Lent

In keeping with the mood of solemn preparation that characterizes the Lenten season, there will be no recessional hymn at all Masses during Lent—weekdays and weekends.

We ask that you please remain standing quietly in your pews until the celebrant has left the church at the end of Mass. Thank you.

Stations of the Cross

Will be held Friday evenings at 6:00pm, beginning February 16 until March 23 and at 10am on March 30.

Day of Prayer and Fasting for Peace

At the Angelus address on Sunday, February 4, 2018, Pope Francis invited all the Church to observe Friday, February 23, as a Day of Prayer and Fasting for Peace, mindful of the many areas of conflict in the world, particularly the Democratic Republic of the Congo, and South Sudan. The Apostolic Nuncio to Canada, Archbishop Luigi Bonazzi, affirms “... the deep desire of Pope Francis that all the Church be united with him in this day of prayer.”


