ustice **Blockage**

In today's Gospel, Jesus was not comparing God to an unjust judge. He was saying that we have to challenge the unjust judges in our lives to clear the way to approach

God as the one who will deliver true love and justice. And where do most of the unjust judges in our lives reside?

In our heads.

Every one of us has an unjust judge inside that keeps us from being connected to the love and compassion of God. That unjust judge is the voice inside that continually whispers things like, "You're not good enough. You don't deserve God's love and mercy because you keep failing at being a good Christian. You don't pray enough. God is so disappointed in you. God doesn't ever listen to your prayers...why would he even bother with someone like you?"

Have you ever challenged that inner judge? Have you ever recognized that it is not the voice of God? Challenging your unjust judge means not accepting its judgements as true or right. The widow kept going back to the unjust judge and demanding true justice, not the justice of a lazy and misguided inner magistrate. Your inner judge never encourages you to ask for and believe in God's justice, which is a full flowing river of mercy, but God wants you to continually challenge whatever is being whispered to you and deceiving you about who you really are and is keeping you from experiencing how much God loves you and wants to flood you with his mercy.

God's justice is his mercy. It's not justice the way we humans have defined justice, where we want to mete out punishing consequences to anyone who has done wrong to us. What God longs to show us is his mercy, his true justice. "Will not God grant justice to his chosen ones who cry to him day and night? Will he delay long in helping them? I tell you, God will quickly grant justice to them and yet, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"

Probably not, if our inner unjust judges have their say.


