

THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

A few words from our Pastor:-

Continuing the bulletin notices on how a Parish operates, I would like to begin by describing the sacramental constitution of the Church. As the People of God, the Church are those called by Christ in Baptism and sanctified by the Spirit in Confirmation to share in the Father's life. The Church is called, not by man, but by God. Therefore, no human power has the authority to govern the Baptized as the Baptized. The Canadian gov't establishes laws for its own citizens as citizens, but it has no authority in the Kingdom of God. However, the Church is not an anarchy, but a communion or a family. That is why men are called as Bishops to pastor the Church in Jesus' name through the Sacrament of Holy Orders. The Bishops are like our spiritual fathers, hence the antiquity of calling our priests, "Father" in seeming contradiction to Christ's command. Being a Bishop does not make a man holy in the sense of being a saint nor does it make him more important in the eyes of God. As St Augustine said: I am Baptized for my benefit; I am a Bishop for your benefit.

Ideally, a Bishop is competent in governance, preaching, and charity, but no man is "competent" save for Christ himself. In a way, the Bishop reveals Christ to the Church both when he presides well and when he doesn't. In the former case, we see an example of Christian life; in the latter, we are reminded that we are a fallen people and that no one is good but God alone.

A priest shares (or participates) in the priesthood of the Bishop at the Parish level. However, as in the case of the Bishop, just because I have a mandate as pastor of this Parish, it does not mean that I am universally competent in every area of Parish life. It also does not mean that I am free from all temptations to corruption. Far from it! If a cleric breaks the just laws of the land or the commands of God, we should be held accountable. Therefore, to support the decision making of the priest and to ward off corrupt practices, Church law mandates a Finance Committee and suggests a Pastoral Council to provide necessary checks and balances. In the Diocese of Victoria, we have gone above and beyond this expectation and I will begin to explain these structures next week.

However, no structure can create justice save for the desire of each individual to do the good.

If you are PAD user, please remember to complete your name and address on the Special Collection envelopes, if you would like to receive a tax receipt.


