The Best...Servant

We are back again skandalon, a with stumbling block sourced in rivalry. and John James were angling for the status of sitting at Jesus's right and left hand in his glory. No doubt, the glory they envisioned was the defeat of the Romans and the freedom from heavy taxes and Roman cruelty. Since Jesus had recently told them that corrupt wealth was not part of

the Kingdom, they may have been envisioning a redistribution of that wealth and who would be first in line but those in Jesus's exclusive inner circle?

The other disciples were naturally indignant when they heard about the request. Here was this rag tag, motley group, a million lightyears away from what they thought would be an uprising and a political victory and already there was jealousy, dissention and vying for position.

Jesus's words about the highest place being the place of the servant and slave must have been like listening to a foreign language to the disciples. "What is this? No glory? No power? No status? What the heck?" We might chuckle at their lack of true vision, except so often our vision is equally distorted. Don't tell me we're not hung up on success. We are often comparing ourselves or our groups with other individuals or groups and being a little envious if another group has more members or another person seems to have a personal friendship with the priest or the Bishop or someone has great success bringing in funds. It is so hard to let go of the world's idea of success when, from the moment we're born, standards of success are drilled into us. It's very difficult to go from the competitive arena of the marketplace or school and suddenly switch off all those standards when we're with the Christian community. We are often very confused disciples!

The next time you wake up, ask the Lord, "Where can I be a servant today?" It doesn't matter if you're going to school or work or church. "Where can I serve?" should be your first priority.

The rest will be added unto you.




