

THIS WEEK IN THE PARISH

A few words from our Pastor:-

So this week we begin our new year for religious education and Sacramental preparation classes. Ruby, Lidia, the team and I have been spending a good amount of time preparing for this important ministry.

I cannot over-stress the significance of offering quality Catholic education in our Parishes and in our Catholic schools. Learning about Christ and how to live a life as a disciple in the Church is more significant than anything in this life. In fact, it is significantly more important than one's professional education. When we meet God face to face, he will ask for our professional achievements or a copy of our CV.

However, learning about Jesus is more than mere "religion". It is a multi-dimensional discipline that helps us grow in spirit, soul, and body. It is more than accomplishing learning goals and curricula. St Bernadette of Lourdes famously struggled in her own Sacramental preparation classes. Although she struggled to remember some of her prayers and lessons, her faith shone in her life and deeds. On the opposite end, great theological minds are not exempt from error. Nonetheless, there have been many great minds in Church history who brought their gifts to bear in the human and the divine sciences. Just as our children must learn, so must we. A faith that is not growing withers and eventually dies. A living faith, on the other hand, grows and feeds others.


