The Quid Pro Quo Fallacy

*"Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you.
I do not give to you as the world gives."*

The most common understanding of "I do not give to you as the world gives," is that Jesus is talking about his peace because that's the context of the passage and that's probably the right understanding. However, scripture scholars agree that the way Jesus gives peace applies to all his gifts.

So, how does the world give as opposed to how Jesus gives? The world's gifts are conditional and transactional – not really gifts at all. That means that in order to receive from the world, you have to fulfill certain requirements. It's a *quid pro quo*: If you do this or that, then you will get this or that. As one religious writer calls it: it's a meritocracy. You have to accomplish in order to receive. Never mind that the world often reneges on its promised gifts; we just assume that if we work hard and fulfill the requirements, we will receive our just rewards like success, status, and material goods.

Jesus said he does not give as the world gives, so that must mean that his gifts are never conditional, transactional, or limited. They are not dependent on merit or obligation. They are freely and lovingly given. We are the ones who have attached conditions because we are embroiled in worldly attitudes and perceptions and we don't realize when we are projecting those worldly expectations onto our Lord. We can hardly fathom a God who does not operate on a *quid pro quo* system. We hardly dare to believe that his peace, love, and forgiveness could be ours for the asking, not from accomplishing. In the world, we never receive what we want or need unconditionally. Even just approval from parents, teachers, and employers is tied to our behaviour, our work habits, and our output. We ask: "Why should God be any different?"

Before we even accomplish anything or look him in the eyes, he loves us with an everlasting love.

Unmerited love. Wow.

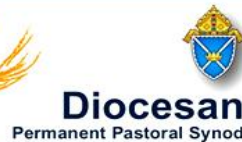

- prepare meeting agendas, capture minutes, and track action items.
- produce an annual report.
- engage with Parish Council and others as needed to provide (financial) input on financial questions, options for solutions, and budget alignment
- liaise with the Diocese's Financial Officer(s) as needed

- assist in establishing budgets, contribute to all agenda items, review potential project costs and options for financial feasibility

Time commitment: approximately 2-6 hours each quarter.
