

So, there's nothing special about a spiritual building in itself, whether it's a basilica, a cathedral or a parish church. Dedicating a building means little; it's what it's dedicated to that's significant. Jesus, in casting out the moneychangers and the sellers of sacrificial animals, was making that statement. He

was saying, "This building isn't holy simply because it's called a temple. It's holy because of the people who pray to the Father and you are making it difficult with all your sacrificial requirements for people to come freely and pray without price. The stones of this temple can, and will be, cast down and rendered useless. But I will become the cornerstone of a new living building of prayer."

If you pay attention to the other readings for this week, you'll see that the Church is still saying that. The first reading is an angel showing Ezekial how a river of living water flows into and through the temple and brings life and fruit to everything it touches. The psalm also talks about the living water that makes glad the City of God. Of course, God is the Living Water but we, too, are called to be "Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells within you?"

The Church is reminding us that we are called to be a living and vibrant Church, not lifeless inhabitants of dead buildings. We don't just come to church; we are church. Note that in Ezekial, the Living Water didn't just flow into a building and sit there stagnating. It flowed through the temple; it enlivened the temple and then it had such wonderful life that it was even able to make stagnant water into living water just by flowing into it.

As Church we are called to be flowing vigorously, with life and dynamism - into the church and out of it. We are supposed to be infectious with life.

I'll let you discern if this is true for you. And if not, why not?





### **Dedication of the** Lateran Basilica November 9

The Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica is a liturgical celebration that pays homage to the first official monument of Christianity, consecrated for the first time on November 9, 318 or 324 by Pope Sylvester I (314-

335) ending the period of Christian persecutions in Rome. In the same period, documented in the Liber Pontifcalis, (a collection of the biographies of the popes from the beginning of the 6th century) there were numerous gifts that the emperor made in favour of the Lateran Church: a series of precious liturgical furnishings, including seven silver altars.

This historical turning point, in the guise of "royal power" traced by the famous Edict of Milan in 313, passes through the construction works of the imposing Basilica of Saint John Lateran that began immediately after Constantine's victory in the battle of the Milvian Bridge in 312. It is a construction, that of the Cathedral of Rome, which represents an ex-voto of gratitude for the triumph obtained against his rival Maxentius. In the famous story by Eusebius of Caesarea reported in the *Vita Costantini*, on the eve of the battle the future emperor saw "the trophy of a cross of light" appear in the sky with an inscription next to it: "In hoc signo vinces" (By this sign, you will conquer); a sign that Constantine had fixed on a labarum, a golden rod in the shape of a cross surmounted by a crown with the Christogram (XP).

To make the Christian religion the "banner" under which to unite the empire, Constantine decided to return to the Church not only the property confiscated during the period of Christian persecutions, but also to make available to Christian communities various lands on the fringes of the walls of the City, what would become Rome's "Christian pole." This included the large area of the Lateran. In the Constantinian building process, a work of importance within the Lateran complex is the baptistery that the emperor himself had built near the basilica, the oldest sacred building intended for the Rite of the Sacrament of Baptism, making the Lateran basilica the "prototype of Christian churches."

The Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica recalls these historical and archaeological memories that French for historian and archaeologist, Paul Veyne, represented the beginning of a "Christian



Europe." It was only in 1724, under the pontificate of Benedict XIII, that this feast extended to all the churches of the Roman Rite to pay homage to the "mother church of the churches of Rome and the world."




